Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 16 contains a reversion clause in the statute authorizing the Game and Parks Commission to convey a public park to Chase County.

Section 1 amends 90-278, which authorizes the Game and Parks Commission to convey Champion Mill State Historical Park to Chase County, by adding language that requires that title to the property remain with Chase County unless the property is no longer operated as a public park, or if the park becomes financially detrimental to the county. In either case, title shall then revert to the Game and Parks Commission.

Section 2 repeals the original section.
