A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to civil procedure; to amend section 25-1552,
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 provisions relating to personal property exemptions in
4 cases of forced sale on execution; and to repeal the
5 original section.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 25-1552, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 25-1552 Each natural person residing in this state shall
4 have exempt from forced sale on execution the sum of ~~two thousand~~
5 ~~five hundred~~ five thousand dollars in personal property, except
6 wages. The provisions of this section do not apply to the exemption
7 of wages, that subject being fully provided for by section 25-1558.
8 In proceedings involving a writ of execution, the exemption from
9 execution under this section shall be claimed in the manner provided
10 by section 25-1516. The debtor desiring to claim an exemption from
11 execution under this section shall, at the time the request for
12 hearing is filed, file a list of the whole of the property owned by
13 the debtor and an indication of the items of property which he or she
14 claims to be exempt from execution pursuant to this section and
15 section 25-1556, along with a value for each item listed. The debtor
16 or his or her authorized agent may select from the list an amount of
17 property not exceeding the value exempt from execution under this
18 section according to the debtor's valuation or the court's valuation
19 if the debtor's valuation is challenged by a creditor.
